Hope Johnson, Paige's twin, was a star on defense with a key interception in the second half that shut down the seniors' drive. The juniors' defense was stout keeping the seniors off the board and preserving the shutout.

## Defense Key In Orange/Black Game Battle For Quarterback Just Beginning

As Tyreese Wigfall and Doug Crawford took most of the reps at quarterback in spring practice, it looks like there's a third quarterback who may be a front-runner for the job when the Bulldogs hit camp in the fall.

Tre'Pavis Mobley, the standout junior wide receiver, took over at quarterback and led the Orange team to a 6-0 win over the Black squad in the annual intrasquad scrimmage Friday night at Bulldog Stadium.

The lone score came with 5:12 left to play on Mobley's 16-yard quarterback draw to lead the Orange team to the win. His score came in a defensive battle where both squads shined. Doug Crawford led the Black team's offense.

There was a process in determining which players would represent each team. Coaches drafted the players, but there was some running involved to determine who received the first pick.

The coaches didn't run. Two players



"It was a lot of fun," Mobley said, who took some snaps last year in the Wildcat formation. "I love playing quarterback. Before I came to Zephyrhills three years ago from Palm Bay, that is the position I played.

"Coach Carroll is running the perfect style of offense for me."

Carroll isn't tipping his hand about who will lineup under center this fall.

"He's an amazing athlete," Carroll said of Mobley. "We wanted to get him some reps to see what he looks like. He's an option for us. We'll see."

On the defensive side on both squads, Sam Bergeron, Caleb Keeling, Javarious Wilson and Alex Winbigler

stood out making big plays.

"It was so much fun to go out there with my teammates and just compete," Keeling said. "Coach Carroll always talks about competitive excellence and that's what this is.

"We go at it every day not just to be good in the spring but to get better for the fall. Champions are made in the spring."

This was also a chance to evaluate players who will be moving up to replace the tremendous group of seniors who graduate next week.

"It's fun to play with new players," said Bergeron, who saw action on the defensive line. "We had some great seniors leave and we, as juniors, had to step up and fill in that spot and be leaders of the team."

Standout receiver Ja'quan Sheppard, who has more than two dozen Division I scholarship offers, was happy to get out on the field and play in game situations.

"This is great to see where this team is at," said Sheppard, who had 16 touchdowns last season. "It is a great start to where we are going to go next season. This

team can be greater than we were last year. We have to put in the work and the heart to get there."

Prior to the scrimmage, Carroll and his staff had a series of scripted plays where the offense and defense were put to the test. Crawford took most of the snaps at quarterback during that portion of the practice.

In the scripted plays, Keontae Lanier, a transfer student, showed his skills at running back by scoring a touchdown. Crawford was able to connect with Mobley on a pass play for another score. Cartrell Strong added another score.

The Bulldogs travel to East Ridge tonight for the annual Spring Game.

"I'm so ready," Mobley said. "I love hitting with my boys on this team, but I'm ready to hit with them against somebody else."

The game, for seniors only, gave them one last opportunity to take the field as a high school player.



# PHSC Pharmacy Technician Program Opens Registration

Pasco-Hernando State College is accepting applications for its Pharmacy Technician Certificate program that begins in August 2018. The Pharmacy Technician program prepares students to work as pharmacy technicians in retail and hospital settings under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist. The limited access

program, with a maximum of 12 students in each cohort, provides students an opportunity to earn a certificate in less than a year when attending full time.
